



Beware of Fake Job Calls

— How the Fraud Happens

1 Suspicious Call or Message



Fake recruiters contact you via phone, WhatsApp, SMS or email.

2 Attractive Job Offer



High salary, work-from-home promise.

3 Fake Credentials



Fake offer letters, ID cards shown.

4 Demand for Payment



Asked to pay fees or share bank details.

5 Pressure & Urgency



Rushed to act quickly

6 Disappearance



Scammer vanishes after payment.

KEY WARNING SIGNS

- ➡ **Request** for money or bank details
- ➡ **Emails** from free or non-official domains
- ➡ **Checkmark** Report suspected fraud at: <https://sancharsaathi.gov.in>
- ➡ **Checkmark** If Fraud has occurred:
Report at cybercrime.gov.in or call 1930
