



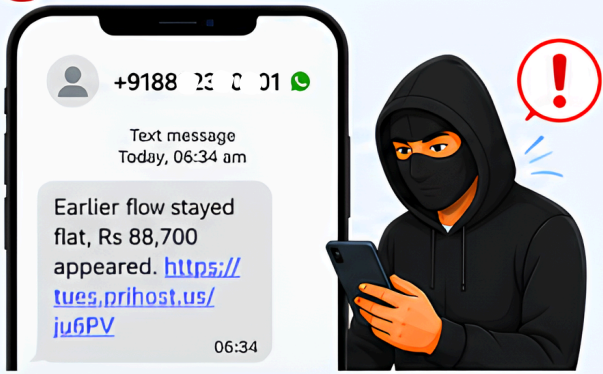

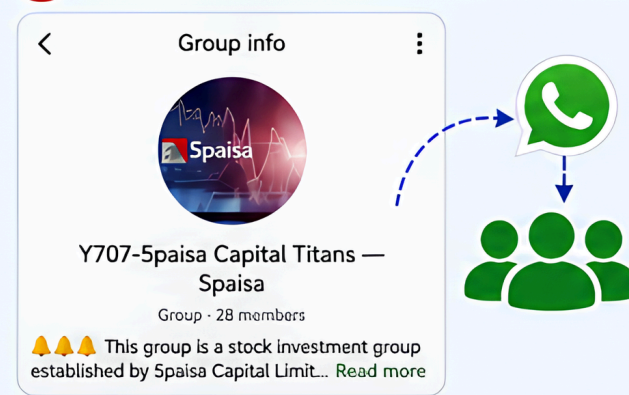
HOW INVESTMENT SCAM HAPPENS

1 10 DIGIT MESSAGE WITH LINK



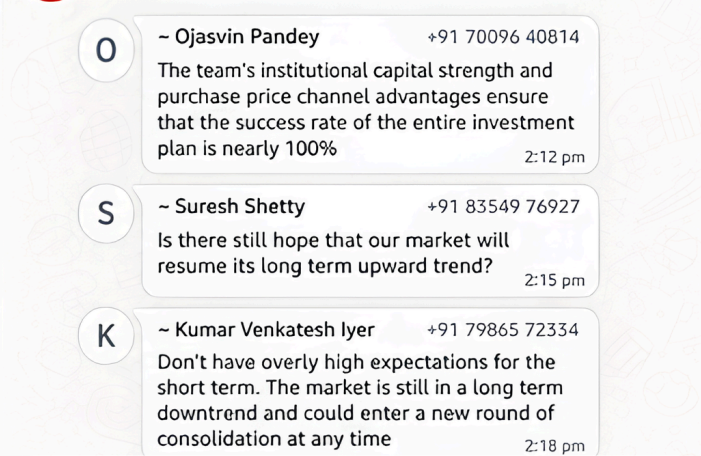
Victims receive messages from unknown 10-digit numbers with short links promising high returns or investment opportunities

2 LINK TAKES YOU TO WHATSAPP GROUP



The link redirects victims to a whatsapp group

3 GROUP HAS ADMINS, PROFESSORS & DUMMY USERS



Scammers pose as fake admins, so-called professors, and dummy users to create a false sense of credibility.

4 THEY SHOW FAKE APP & HIGH RETURNS



- High Returns Guaranteed
- Low Risk Investments
- Daily Profit Updates
- Consistent Growth

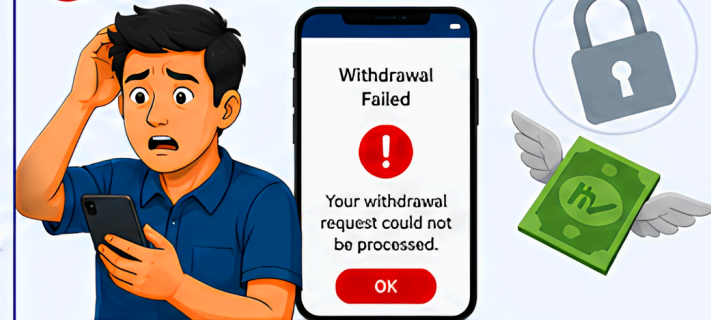
Dummy users share fake profit screenshots to lure victims into investing. Admins share fake investment apps and dashboards with promises of high and consistent returns.

5 VICTIM INVESTS HIGH AMOUNT



Believing the fake profits and testimonials, victim invest large amount of money through bank transfers or UPI

6 THEY SUFFER HUGE LOSS



Victims keep investing until they attempt to withdraw their money. Scammers then demand repeated charges, leading to realization of fraud and significant financial loss.

KEY WARNING SIGNS

- Receive SMS/RCS/online messaging platform with links from unknown numbers.
- Promises of high returns with little or no risk.
- Fake screenshots of profits by dummy users with fake success stories.
- Sharing APK files or links to unregistered investment platforms.
- Requests to transfer money to personal bank accounts, UPI IDs, or digital wallets, etc.

- Verify bank details through Trusted Contact Details from sanchar saathi portal
- Verify stock trading apps of broker for verified label before downloading from Google Play Store
- Report suspected fraud at: www.sancharsaathi.gov.in
- If Fraud has already occurred: Report at cybercrime.gov.in or call 1930
